## EXPLANATION OF THIS FORM

General. Our goal is to foster research; student theses, once finished and graded, will be posted on our blog at <http://osr.cs.fau.de> in full. This includes the name of the student, abstract, work description, and final thesis. Please do not put sensitive information into your final thesis (e.g. no birth date).

Ad 1. This is a legal blurb (in German) that the university expects every student to sign. Except for the most unusual circumstances, a student should check this off. Unusual circumstances are an agreement with an industry partner that the student thesis should be kept confidential.

Ad 2. The legal blurb from 1. above is quite old and not up to the times. To foster open collaboration between researchers and the public, we ask that students provide to the general public, not just the university, a use and remix right as spelled out by the Creative Commons License BY 4.0.

Both 1. and 2. relate to the actual written thesis only. Underlying research data or source code is not affected. (Which makes these two clauses almost useless.) However, if a student works closely with the professorship, we will need joint rights to any research data and source code. Hence:

Ad 3. Students who actively work with our own research projects must sign the contributor agreement linked to from this clause. Otherwise we will not be able to have the student work on the chosen topic. This clause allows us to continue the student's work once he or she is gone. It is mandatory.
